

- वहिसार **Vahnisara**: A form of Antardhauti in which the navel is made to touch the spinal column.
- वराह **Varaha**: One of the incarnations of God, according to Hindu mythology; the Boar, the third incarnation of Lord Vishnu.
- वारिसार **Varisara**: A form of Antardhauti by which the body is filled with water which is then evacuated by the anus.
- वर्ण **Varna**: A form of letter; colour; caste.
- वर्णाश्रम **Varnasrama**: Related to the four primary groups and the four stages of Hindu life; the laws of the caste and stage of life.
- वर्णात्मकशब्द **Varnatmakasabda**: Lettered sound which has meaning.
- वरुण **Varuna**: The divine intelligence presiding over the element of water.
- वरुणबीज **Varunabija**: The syllable "Vam".
- वरुणलोक **Varunaloka**: The world of the Lord of Waters.
- वासना **Vasana**: Subtle desire; a tendency created in a person by the doing of an action or by enjoyment; it induces the person to repeat the action or to seek a repetition of the enjoyment; the subtle impression in the mind capable of developing itself into action; it is the cause of birth and experience in general; the impression of actions that remains unconsciously in the mind.
- वासनाक्षय **Vasanakshaya**: Annihilation of subtle desires.
- वासनारहित **Vasanarahita**: Without subtle desires.
- वासनात्याग **Vasanatyaga**: Renunciation of subtle desires.
- वशीकार **Vasikara**: Control; highest stage of lower Vairagya.
- वशित्व **Vasitva**: One of the eight Siddhis by which the Yogi gets control over everything.
- वस्तु **Vastu**: Object; substance; Brahman.
- वात **Vata**: Wind; one of the three humours of the body; rheumatism.
